Terms and Conditions (Individual Golf Bookings)

Handicaps

- Handicap restrictions of 24 for gentlemen and 32 for ladies and juniors apply to The Brabazon and the PGA National golf courses. There is no handicap restriction for The Derby golf course.

Tee Times

- Before commencing play all golfers must report to Golf Reception – a green fee ticket will be issued which must be presented to the Starter.
- Golfers to be on their starting tee 10 minutes before their allotted tee time.
- All golfers are expected to play from the 1st tee, unless otherwise instructed.
- The Belfry reserves the right to amend any tee time.
- The Belfry reserves the right to make all groups into four balls.
- All cancellations must be advised to Golf Reception within 24 hours of the booked tee time and The Belfry reserves the right to charge for any tee times booked and not utilised (including any reduction in numbers).
- Twilight: If, due to demand on the golf courses, a booking falls within a Twilight time, golfers may not finish the full 18 holes due to lack of daylight. The green fee paid reflects this and it is regretted that no compensation for, or reduction in the green fee can be offered.

Pace of Play

- All golf is played in four balls and each round of golf should be completed within the following times:

- Slow play must be avoided at all times. Course Marshals monitor the pace of play on each golf course and The Belfry reserves the right to ask players to speed up: in severe circumstances golfers will be asked to pick up and walk a hole in order to stay on time. The decision of the Course Marshal is final.
- The Belfry Golf Team has the right to move golfers onto a less challenging golf course if their ability and pace of play does not meet the desired standard of the course they have initially chosen and it is regretted that no compensation for, or reduction in the green fee can be offered.

Dress Code & Etiquette

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Football shirts or tracksuits
- Shirts pulled outside of trousers
- Sports shorts, beach shorts, blue denim trousers or cargo shorts
- Trousers tucked into socks or shorts with long socks rolled down
- Training shoes

ACCEPTABLE

- Men's shirts must have a collar and sleeves (turtle/rollneck acceptable)
- Shirts tucked inside trousers
- Tailored shorts or long trousers
- Long or short socks may be worn with shorts
- Golf shoes - preferably with soft spikes
- Golfing headwear to be worn correctly

IF YOU ARE NOT PROPERLY DRESSED YOU
WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON THE COURSE

- The Rules of Golf and The Belfry Golf Course Etiquette must be adhered to at all times on the golf courses and the main putting green and full details are available upon request.
- Soft spikes may be worn throughout the resort.
- Pitch marks must be repaired, divots replaced and bunkers raked.
- Anyone acting in a dangerous or disruptive manner or not following The Belfry Golf Course Etiquette will be asked to leave the golf course, driving range or putting greens and no refund can be made.
- One set of golf clubs must be used per player.
- Mobile phones are allowed on course but must be used with respect for other golfers and not affect the pace of play.

On-Course Refreshments

- No food and beverage, other than that purchased from The Belfry, may be consumed on site.
- No glass of any description is allowed on the golf courses, driving range or putting greens.

Buggies and Trolleys

- The hire of golf buggies and pull trolleys is sold in good faith at the time of making a reservation.
- The Belfry reserves the right to restrict/ban the use of golf buggies and trolleys, in accordance with weather conditions prevailing at the time.
- A decision will be made by the Head Greenkeeper each day at 'first light', or 30 minutes before the first tee time (whichever is the earlier), regarding the use of buggies and trolleys.
- Under no circumstances can The Belfry accept medical exemptions.
- A maximum of two people is allowed per buggy and each buggy must keep to the path (where applicable) and be driven well away from the greens, surrounds and teeing areas.
- No buggy may be driven by any person under the age of sixteen years.
- If, in the opinion of the Golf Duty Manager, a buggy is being driven in a dangerous manner, it will immediately be removed from the user. No refund or credit will be given in these circumstances.
- If no restrictions are in force, all buggies and trolleys will be charged as booked.

Weather Conditions

- **Rain**
 - In the event of adverse weather conditions, play will be suspended if, in the opinion of The Belfry Golf Team, the golf course is unfit for play.
- **Fog**
 - *Pre Play:* If the water fountain on the 9th / 18th Lake is not visible from the PGA National Starter's hut, or visibility is less than 150 yards on the course, golfers cannot be allowed to commence their game.
 - *Players on the course:* If visibility reduces to below 150 yards, golfers on course may continue to play, at their own risk – any golfers wishing to suspend their game may return to the Golf Centre and will only then return to the golf course at the discretion of the Golf Duty Manager.
 - The Golf Duty Manager, together with the Head Greenkeeper, will make the final decision.
- **Frost**
 - In the event of frost, any decision will be made by the Head Greenkeeper.
- **Snow**
 - In the event of snow, any decision will be made by the Head Greenkeeper.

Play Delayed/Suspended or Cancelled due to Adverse Weather Conditions

- Where play is delayed / suspended or cancelled due to adverse weather conditions, this will be considered an Act of God. In such circumstances, if the golfer is able to complete 12 holes of play, no compensation will be offered.
- In the event that the golfer is unable to complete at least 12 holes, the booking will be cancelled and a voucher to the equivalent value will be issued to the golfer for a return visit.
- No refunds can be offered in any circumstances.

Golf Tuition at The Belfry

- All golf tuition at The Belfry may only be carried out by Golf Professionals in the employ of The Belfry. However, if a customer wishes to bring his / her own Golf Professional on site, this must be agreed by The Belfry at least 48 hours in advance, and a charge will be made equal to The Belfry's selling price for the equivalent tuition by a Golf Professional in its employ.

Liability

- The Belfry cannot accept any liability for accident, injury or misadventure. Players are responsible for making their own insurance arrangements in respect of any injuries suffered or caused to them, or caused by them to any third party.
- The Belfry cannot accept any responsibility for the loss of or damage to property belonging to any golfer.
